






Roundwood Removals in the UNECE 2002









Global Industrial Roundwood Production in 2002






Global Industrial Roundwood Production in 2002







Production of energy from wood fuels in 2000








Roundwood Balance in the UNECE in 2002





Roundwood Consumption in the UNECE Region










Roundwood Trade in the UNECE






Roundwood Exports in Europe 2002





Wood Chip Trade in Europe in 2002








Conifer Sawlog Price Index 1995-2003






Conifer Sawlog Cost in 2q/2003






Conifer Pulplog Price Index 1995-2003

In 2002:

- Total removals within UNECE were close to record levels.
- Roundwood removals increased substantially within the CIS and Other Europe.
- Almost 15 % of roundwood removals were used as fuel wood.
- Exports of roundwood from Russia were 14% higher than the previous year.
- Raw material costs for pulpmills and sawmills fell in many regions.
